# TIME TRIAL


Sunday June 24, 2018

*Start time*: 10:00 am, Sunday June 24, 2018. The start line is south of Hwy 28 from Bon Accord Community School on RR 240. Cyclists will be leaving at 1 minute intervals.

The Start List will be made Friday, June 22, 2018 and posted online on Zone 4.

\*\*\*NO RIDING (Other Than Racing) on the ITT course in either direction after 10:00\*\*\*

*Directions:* From Edmonton travel on the Anthony Henday to Hwy 28 (97st). Go north on Hwy 28 for 27.5 km to the town of Bon Accord. Turn on 57 st with the school on the right-hand side.



#### TIME TRIAL COURSE

The time trial course is an out and back course on Range Road 240, also known as Sunnyside Road. The course starts just south of Hwy 28 and proceeds south for 12.6 km, just north of Hwy 37, where the turnaround is and return to start north to the start/finish near Bon Accord. The course is a rolling course with 111m of elevation gain during the 25 km.

## REGULATIONS

- No team or unauthorized following vehicles in Time Trial.
- Do not cross the finish line, in either direction, more than once at the end of the race.
- Please respect law enforcement and locals. Do not antagonize.

- Riders should at all times ride single file when not racing.
- This event will be run according to ABA/CC/UCI regulations. Riders are responsible for knowing and understanding the rules. They are available online.
- The ABA complies with and fully supports the UCI antidoping regulations, the clauses of the World Antidoping Code and its international Standards to which the UCI antidoping regulations refer and to the antidoping regulations of other competent bodies as per the regulations of the UCI.

- Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated, including but not limited to public urination, littering, use of profane language and verbal abuse of officials or community members.
- Riders in Categories 1/2 and 3 may be subject to bike check before or after the race. Riders whose bikes do not comply with UCI & CCA regulations will be allowed to ride but will not be eligible for prizes.


